

Bowl/Container Install Instructions

- 1. Follow all EI and or match lit instructions carefully (Included and available at HPCfire.com)
- 2. Proper venting is required as illustrated above
 - a. Vent blocks must be installed on all units

Fixed Piping Only

18 Sq. Inch Vents

On Opposing Sides

- Utilize the provided vent blocks
- b. Additional venting is required if there is a cavity under the bowl/container

ATTENTION: Warranty will be voided if there is no proper ventilation

- 3. Hook up water if applicable
 - a. Water flow is estimated to be 700~900 GPH
 - b. It is recommended to put a valve after the pump to trim water flow if desired
 - c. Consult your pool or pond professional for line and pump sizing
- 4. Leak test all gas and/or water fittings
- 5. If using an electronic control system it must be kept dry
- 6. Access panel is included on applicable models
- 7. On product with CSA certified fire pits install the startup shut down instruction near the valve or switch which is used to start the fire pit
 - a. CSA certified match lit models will have startup shut down labels on the inside of the access door on applicable models

WARNING: Follow all attached electronic ignition and/or match lit instructions carefully. If you do not have the additional instructions contact your dealer or sales person.
