## You will need a ½" and ¾6" Wrench for assembly.

- Package Contains your fire ring panels and hardware to assemble .
- Remove all contents from the box.
- Set all panels on the ground to form a circle.
- Line the vertical slotted holes up with the horizontal slotted holes.
- Insert the bolt through the holes.
- Place nuts on bolts and hand tighten.
- Use a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " &  $\frac{7}{16}$ " wrench and tighten all bolts securely.
